## **Consent for The integrated4 Solution**

The integrated4 Solution Implant Bridge is an implant supported fixed/detachable implant supported bridge that replaces missing teeth in an upper or lower dental arch. The term fixed/detachable means that the integrated4 Solution Implant bridge is permanently attached to the implants but can be removed by a dentist if needed. Our goal is to provide 12 teeth per arch with the integrated4 Solution bridge. This has been shown to be adequate for function and aesthetics. Sometimes due to jaw shape, bone quality, and bone quantity, fewer than 12 teeth per arch is preferable so that the implants supporting the integrated4 Solution bridge itself are not overstressed. This will still provide adequate function and aesthetics for most people.

We want our patient to understand that the treatment sequence to replace missing teeth through the protocol we utilize can vary for each patient. The actual total treatment time can be as short as 4 months but, due to the possible need for bone grafting and waiting for the ideal time to load the placed implants, the length of treatment could take up to a year. We offer an estimate of your treatment time before we start but due to clinical circumstances this may vary once treatment begins. The number of appointments also varies depending on clinical circumstances and can range from 11 to 18 or more appointments.

It is our goal to provide the final integrated4 Solution Implant bridge in as short of a treatment time as possible while maintaining clinical excellence. The actual treatment time cannot be determined until the first surgical appointment. At this time, the doctor will decide whether or not the bone is stable enough to support implants and if grafting is needed. The total treatment time can usually be estimated following this appointment.

It is a priority of ours to make sure that during your treatment you have temporary teeth so that you can chew, smile, and live your life well. The type of temporary teeth that we provide will also depend on the clinical situation. They may be a complete denture, partial denture, and implant supported temporary or a tooth supported temporary.

Lastly, as can be seen in the above image, a pink area above the teeth might be needed for clinical reasons. Once again, each clinical situation is different, but in the end our goal is to achieve ideal aesthetics for your treatment results.
